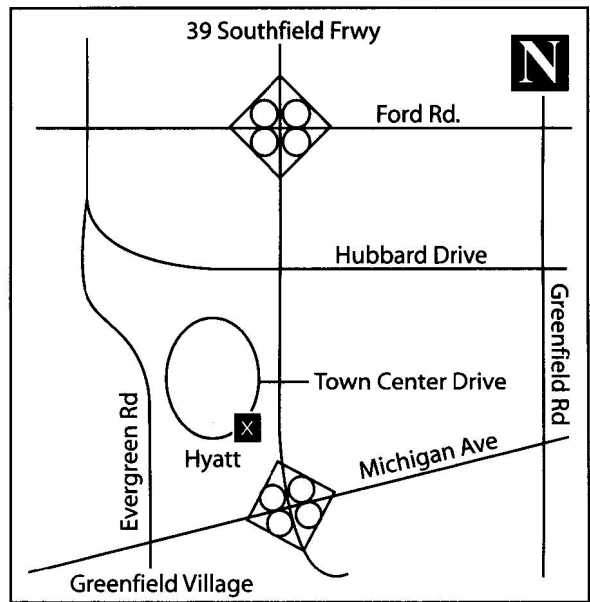

Conventions are special events, not regular meetings. A large conference requires a substantial amount of planning, preparation and expense. March Round Up Conventions are held in hotels, and there is a charge for the use of their facilities. Costs include travel and lodging for speakers, coffee, printing and postage, to name a few.

**The March Round Up Convention is self-supporting.** Costs of the event are paid by registration fees. No baskets are passed. Cost is nominal compared to a weekend's entertainment elsewhere. Our goal is to break even financially. Attendance is voluntary. As responsible A.A. Members, we pay our own way.
